ZIMUN AWARDS CRITERIA

Criteria	Description
Participation	<ul> <li>The delegate is able to submit relevant and insightful (POI's, speeches, amendments, resolutions) that contributed to the development of the debate</li> <li>The delegate remains respectful towards fellow delegates, chairs, admin, and guests throughout the entire conference.</li> <li>The delegate is eager to participate in debate whenever new arguments are introduced. <ul> <li>The delegate willingly participates in the debate and does not need to be called upon by the chair.</li> </ul> </li> <li>The delegate is actively engaged in the debate even when they are not speaking <ul> <li>The delegate communicates with their bloc members and submits amendments</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Preparation	<ul> <li>Any and all points made by the delegate clearly reflect/indicate extensive research efforts and debate preparations         <ul> <li>The delegate uses quotes, statistics, and data to support their claims or debunk the claims of others</li> <li>"The delegate consistently portrays their country's political, economic, and foreign interests and views accurately throughout the conference" (JOMUN).</li> </ul> </li> <li>The delegate is well versed on the given committee topics         <ul> <li>The delegate presents relevant historical facts, data, and statistics regarding the given topic in both past and current contexts</li> <li>"The delegate is well-versed with the rules and procedures of ZIMUN debate and seeks clarification from the chairs when needed" (JOMUN)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Debate and Negotiation	<ul> <li>The delegates' debating skills are confident and versatile</li> <li>The delegate consistently exhibits excellent and confident public speaking skills</li> <li>The delegate displays strong communication skills in a register appropriate to a ZIMUN debate.</li> <li>"The delegate showcases a level of collaboration with other delegates in order to create effective solutions to the topics debated" (JOMUN)</li> <li>The delegate is able to respond to POIs while effectively maintaining their position on their topic.</li> </ul>

Communication	<ul> <li>The delegate displays strong communication skills in a register appropriate to a ZIMUN debate(JOMUN)</li> <li>The delegate's use of language is formal and respectful (JOMUN)</li> <li>The delegate consistently speaks clearly and coherently</li> <li>The delegate does not engage in profanity or other disrespectful language. (JOMUN)</li> <li>The delegate is capable of delivering nuance in their speeches or POIs. (JOMUN)</li> <li>The delegate demonstrates effective diplomatic collaboration skills</li> <li>The delegate comfortably shares their ideas with their bloc members</li> </ul>

Best Delegate	<ul> <li>The delegate has submitted a position paper and 2 operative clauses to the chair as was instructed</li> <li>Most knowledgeable and prepared delegate in the committee room</li> <li>Exhibits leadership skills by helping to steer the committee toward a collective resolution</li> <li>Shows an exceptional understanding of the issues at hand</li> <li>Actively participates in committee sessions</li> <li>Demonstrates strong negotiation and persuasion skills</li> <li>Provides innovative and constructive solutions to problems</li> <li>Consistently adheres to the rules of</li> </ul>	Demonstrates: conceptual awareness, insight, and knowledge and understanding which are evident in the skills of critical thinking; a high level of ability to provide answers which are fully developed, structured in a logical and coherent manner and illustrated with appropriate examples and data; precise use of MUN terminology which is specific to the topic; the ability to analyze and evaluate evidence and to synthesize knowledge a come to reasonable conclusions/solutions; A diplomatic awareness of different perspectives and contexts; consistent evidence of critical and reflective diplomatic thinking; a high level of proficiency in analyzing and evaluating global issues and utilizing problem-solving skills.

Most Honourable/ Outstanding Delegate	<ul> <li>The delegate has submitted a position paper and 2 operative clauses to the chair as was instructed</li> <li>Demonstrates effective negotiation and debate skills</li> <li>Displays a thorough understanding of the issues discussed</li> <li>Offers practical and insightful solutions to the committee</li> <li>Shows respect for the rules of procedure and other delegates</li> <li>Actively contributes to debates and discussions</li> </ul>	Demonstrates: detailed knowledge and understanding; answers which are coherent, logically structured and well developed; consistent use of appropriate MUN terminology; an ability to analyze, evaluate and synthesize knowledge and concepts; knowledge of relevant research. A diplomatic awareness of different perspectives and contexts; an ability to analyze and evaluate global issues and utilize problem-solving skills.
Most Promising Delegate	<ul> <li>The delegate has submitted a position paper and 2 operative clauses to the chair as was instructed</li> <li>Eager to contribute ideas and solutions to the committee</li> <li>Respects the rules of procedure and fellow delegates</li> <li>Demonstrates budding communication and negotiation skills</li> <li>Shows potential in understanding the issues discussed</li> </ul>	Demonstrates: a sound knowledge and understanding of the topic using MUN-specific terminology at times used incorrectly; answers which are logically structured and coherent but not fully developed; an ability to provide competent answers with some attempt to integrate topic-specific knowledge and concepts; a tendency to be more descriptive than evaluative (although some ability is demonstrated to prove an understanding of contrasting diplomatic views/opinions); some evidence of critical thinking; an ability to somewhat analyze and evaluate data and utilize problem-solving skills
